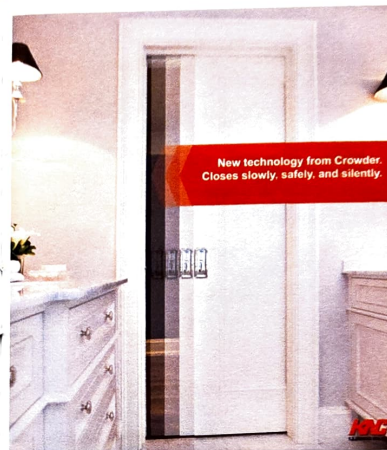

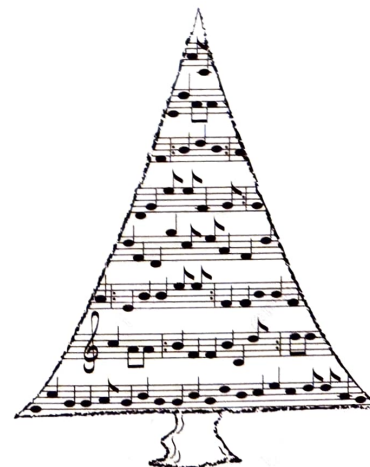

🎵 Program Notes 🎵

🎵 **It's The Most Wonderful Time of the Year** - and no, we don't mean back to school - it's the Christmas season! Swing into the holidays with this classic song first recorded by *Andy Williams* in 1963. A great start to what is sure to be 'the hap-happiest concert of all!'

🎵 **A Legend of Kings** celebrates the journeys of legendary secular and sacred kings. *Charles Spinney* intertwines La Marche de Rois, We Three Kings, Good King Wenceslas, and Once in Royal David's City on this rousing voyage.

🎵 The traditional English tune 'Greensleeves' is given a new stylistic treatment in *Ed Huckeby's What Child Is This*. It starts with a flowing lyrical movement which gives way to a lively and syncopated multi-metric rendition.

🎵 *Leroy Anderson* wrote the quintessential winter hit **Sleigh Ride** in July 1946 during a summer heat wave. It consistently ranks near the top of holiday playlists and has been performed and recorded by a wider array of music artists than any piece in the history of Western music. It has even become the signature song of the Boston Pops Orchestra!

Have you started your Christmas Shopping yet? *Gloria Shayne's* festive arrangement of Jingle Bells, **Jingle All The Way**, is a tongue-in-cheek take on the joys (and trials!) of Christmas shopping.

Entertaining and exciting, Earlene Rentz's novel arrangement of the Ukrainian Folk Song **Sleigh Bells** moves through interesting counterlines with a festive flair - complete with jingling sleigh bells! A lively pace and wonderful dynamics create an uplifting holiday treat.

The beautiful, haunting melody **Do You Hear What I Hear?** has been sung countless times for over 50 years. Full and rich-sounding, it was originally written as a plea for peace during the Cuban Missile Crisis. The lyrics hold true today - imploring everyone to pray for peace in this troubled world.

INTERMISSION

🎵 Ready for another sleigh ride? Originally written in 1756 by *Leopold Mozart*, **Die Schlittenfahrt** (translated 'The Sleighride') is an updated arrangement which includes the entire band. Listen for the melody as it is tossed from section to section and features the many types of bells found in the percussion section.

🎵 **Brazilian Bell Carol** takes us forward in time 250 years to the streets of Rio de Janeiro. This South American street party features our percussion section and a little festivity of our own!

🎵 In this whirlwind arrangement of the classic 'Jingle Bells' everyone gets a chance to laugh out loud! **Laughing All The Way** will make you forget about shoveling and remember how much fun dashing through the snow can be!

🎵 Penned in 1963 by José Feliciano, **Feliz Navidad** features the traditional Puerto Rican greeting "Feliz Navidad, próspero año y felicidad" which translates to "Merry Christmas, a prosperous year and happiness". Our version features an enlarged percussion section.

Calypso Noel first appeared on the *Johnny Mathis* Christmas Album "Give Me Your Love for Christmas". The simple, folk-like, writing explains why this piece has endured and has been credited for starting the island carol craze.

Heat waves seem to bring out some of the best Christmas work, as is evident in **The Christmas Waltz**. Written for Frank Sinatra in the summer of 1954, this timeless classic has been covered by *Bing Crosby, Mel Torme, Tony Bennett* and more!

Holiday Rock is a delightful original that rocks from start to finish! Listen for musical snippets of well-known holiday favorites.

🎵 **The BCB** and **Dofasco Choirs** come to together to present one of the most quintessential holiday numbers - **The Christmas Song**. In an effort to cool off during a blistering summer heat wave, Robert Wells composed this seasonal favourite in 40 minutes.

Julian Lam was born in Hong Kong and moved to Canada at the age of four. He has played saxophone since the age of 11, but also plays several other instruments including flute and piano. He grew up in Mississauga and completed a joint degree in Music and Computer Science at McMaster. Julian has performed with various local ensembles, including the Fucoso Sax Ensemble, McMaster Concert Band, Sax n' Sync, Health Sciences Musical Pit Band and Mississauga Pops. He was awarded the Merriam School of Music Scholarship from McMaster University in 2010.

His interest in conducting started in 2004 when he co-founded a local musical ensemble – St. Cecelia's Youth Orchestra (SCYO). He was Lead Conductor for SCYO from 2004-2009. During his time studying at McMaster, he completed several conducting and methods courses. In 2015, he received a certificate from the Ontario Band Association Wind Conducting Symposium at York University.

Julian has been involved with the Burlington Concert Band as a performer on and off since 2010, as well as Assistant Conductor since 2015. He stepped in as interim Director of Music since Summer 2019, and he is excited to continue contributing a unique perspective towards music performance. He lives in Burlington with his wife and fellow musician Lisa Liang, and became a new father in September 2019.

NANCY BULLIVANT, DMC DIRECTOR

Nancy Bullivant was born and raised in Eau Claire, Wisconsin. Growing up in a musical family, it was a natural progression to university training in music education as a voice major, followed by studies in church music. Being a church musician is what brought Nancy to Canada over 30 years ago. In that capacity, she has served Baptist and United churches since then.

Nancy's musical career has also included teaching piano, singing in choirs and accompanying. She is the fourth person to direct the Dofasco Male Chorus.

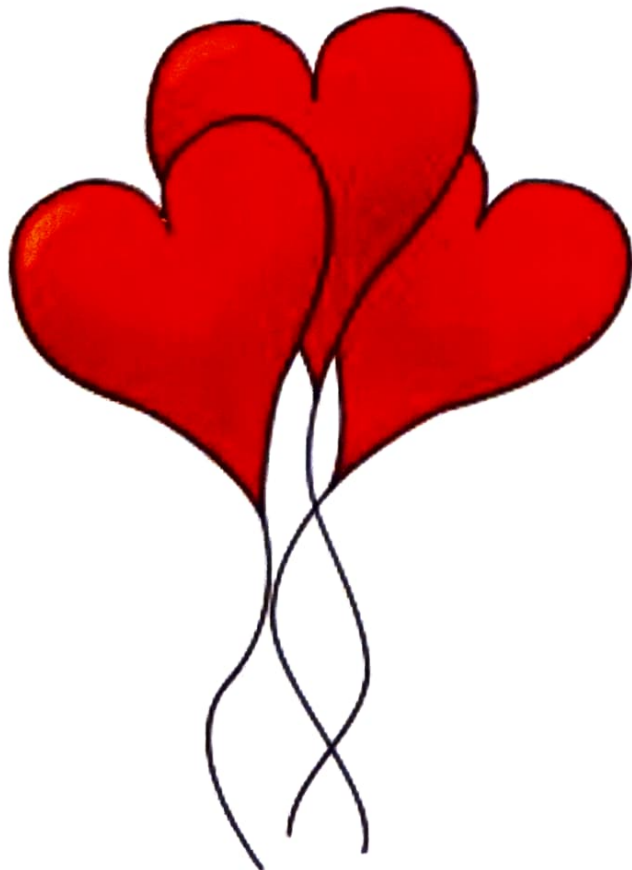
